Ice Skating

- Evergreen Lake at Deerpath Park, next to the softball field
- Willow Lake at Deerpath Park, north of Cherokee Rd. entrance
- Grosse Pointe Pond at Grosse Pointe Blvd. and Hunter Court
- Century Park North adjacent to the Pavilion near the sled hill.

This ice rink will be lit until 9:00 pm daily.

Please note:

- The Park District does not remove snow from the lakes.
- Skating on District property is allowed only when a GREEN flag is flying at the rink or pond.

Sledding

- The District's unsupervised sled hill is located at the north end of Century Park on Indianwood Dr. The sled hill will be lit until 9pm daily.
- Check the posted sign at the hill to see if sledding is permitted on any given day.

The Pavilion restroom entrance will be open daily from 7am-9pm. On weekends, the Pavilion Activity Room will be open from 1pm-9pm, when the ice rink or sled hill is open. It will be staffed and will offer free skate rentals and concession sales.
