## Hoppin' Holiday Hunt

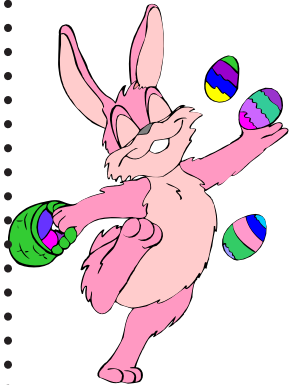

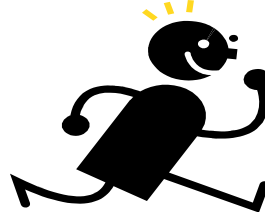

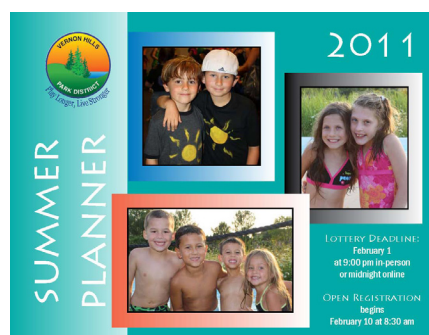
