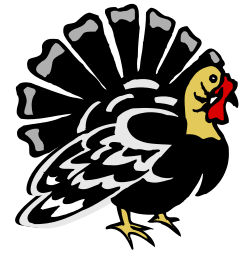
## Parent's Night Out

### Tie Dye, Pottery Painting and Recycled Art

Students begin by creating their own tie dye shirts which are used as painting smocks for the remainder of the program. Shirts are provided. Kids will then be exposed to pottery painting using acrylics and will learn a variety of techniques. Different concepts will be shown as students investigate aspects of color, brushstrokes, sponging, dry-brushing, texturing, and shading. All finished pieces will be glazed and glitter sparkled (if desired) and taken home immediately. In the other sessions the kids will create recycled art projects and a “green” ceramic bowl, plate or mug which will be fired and used at home.
