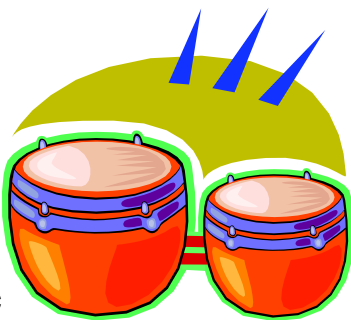

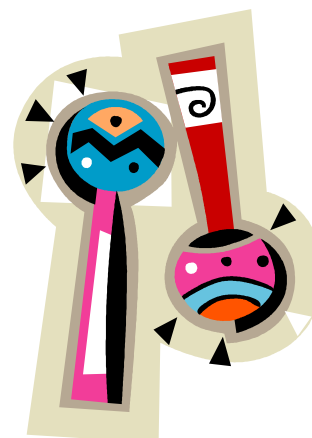

## Kindermusik Imagine That: "Toys I Make, Trips I Take"

Imagine That is a 14-week class specifically for 3-5 year olds. Pretend play activities are integrated with music, vocal development, storytelling, dance, movement and literature to capture your child's potential and learn to encourage their cognitive and literacy skills, creativity and individuality. Their independence is emerging, yet there remains a need for the affirmation and emotional security of a parent. Therefore, a parent or caregiver will join class during the last 15 minutes each week.

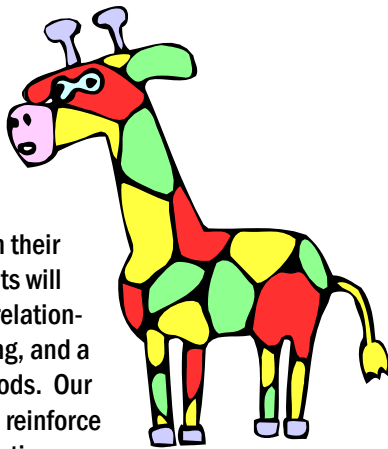
