Chinese Mini Camp

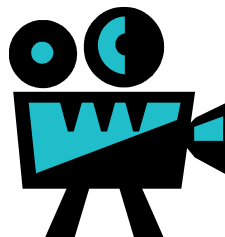

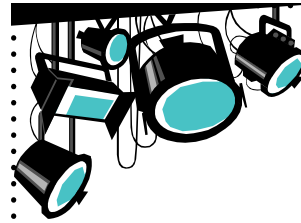
Flight Academy Mini Camp
