FAQ's

What are your teacher/student ratios?

- 2 year: 2 teachers/12 children max.
- Young 3's: 2 teachers/14 children max.
- 3 year: 2 teachers/18 children max.
- 4 year: 2 teachers/18 children max.
- Pre-K: 2 teachers /18 children max.

Do preschoolers need to be potty trained?

Children enrolled in our 2 year old and Young 3's preschool do not need to be potty trained, but please be aware that instructors will not be responsible for changing diapers.

Children in our 3, 4 and Pre-K preschool programs must be potty trained.

What is your discipline policy?

On the rare occasion that we need to discipline a child during the preschool day, we use a brief time-out in the classroom. Our goal in using this technique is to remove a child from the situation long enough to allow him/her to regain control of him/herself.

Positive redirection is another core discipline procedure. Appropriate boundaries and rules for behavior are established early in the school year.

Do you have a Preschool Open House?

Yes, we open our classrooms and our teachers are available to talk to prospective families twice per year.

Our **OPEN HOUSE** will be held on Saturday, **March 27, 2010** from 10:30 am - 12:00 pm. We welcome everyone to come and visit.

Little Learners Preschool Registration

- Registration for each class is determined by computerized lottery. After the lottery deadline has closed, the computer randomly selects registrants up to the maximum number of participants for each program.
- Only sibling registrations may be clipped together.
- If you are a new student, a copy of your child's birth certificate or other proof of your child's birthdate must be submitted by June 1.

Payment Schedule

For your convenience, we are offering an easy payment schedule. A \$100 non-refundable/non-transferable deposit is due with your registration form and will be applied toward your total tuition bill.

The remaining balance is due in three equal payments on:

Friday, June 25, 2010
Friday, September 24, 2010
Friday, December 17, 2010

Please note: Failure to make timely payments will result in forfeiture of your child's place in preschool.
