**Did you know?** . . . Students, including morning kindergarteners, who attend Hawthorn District 73 elementary schools can attend ASE programs right in their school! How ASE works:

- 1) Sign up for classes through the Park District.
- 2) ASE does not take day of registration. Please register in advance.
- 3) Once classes begin, send a note with your child every day to school so the whereabouts of your child is accounted for during dismissal.
- 4) Daily, the schools make an announcement telling students which classroom to go to for ASE classes. Instructors take attendance.
- 5) At ASE class dismissal, instructors walk children outside to be picked up by guardians. If your child(ren) is enrolled in HAC at North or South, the instructor will walk them over to HAC after all children have been picked up.

The week of February 13th-16th will be used for snow make up days for session one T-Th winter classes.

## Sunshine Arts and Crafts Tie Dye, Pottery Painting and Recycled Art

We begin with students creating their own tie dye shirts which are used as painting smocks for the remainder of the term. Shirts are provided. Then kids will be exposed to pottery painting using acrylics and will learn a variety of techniques. Concepts will be demonstrated each week as students investigate aspects of color, brushstrokes, sponging, dry-brushing, texturing, shading and more. All finished art pieces will be glazed and glitter sparkled and taken home. Later sessions will build on these processes with the kids creating recycled art projects and by the final session they will create a "green" ceramic bowl, plate or mug which will be fired and used at home.
