## **A reminder about our health/sickness policy**

PLEASE KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME IF HER/SHE: -has a persistent cough -has a runny nose -has a sore throat -has a fever the night before or the day of school (child must be fever free 24 hours, without the aid of over the counter medications, before returning to school) -vomits the night before or the day of school -has diarrhea the night before or day of school When you send a sick child to class, you expose the children and teachers to the illness. Please be considerate and keep your child home. Please do not be offended if we call and ask you to come to pick up your child. We understand that sometimes a child may seem well before school but become ill during class time. If your child is not feeling well, but wants to come to school, please remember it is in his/her best interest to be at home resting. The recovery time will be quicker. Please notify the school at once if your child has a communicable disease.
