The District invites our community to support Vernon Hills' families that are in financial need. Last year, through event proceeds, P-Card rebates, and Giving Trees, the District's Family Scholarship Fund awarded \$34,000 for recreation programming to 46 families. Together, let's help more children have positive experiences with gifts of recreation. Donations may be made at any time at our Park District facilities.

For 30 years strong, the District has received the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting. The District's Annual Report Summary is included on pages 6.

In 2024, the District completed many projects that benefit our community: the Hartmann Park Master Plan renovation, improvements at Turtle Creek Waterpark including the new sprayground, Hawthorn Mellody Park's new playground, and the adoption of the District's Comprehensive Master Plan.

Beginning in November 2024, the District will be under new leadership! Jeff Fougerousse, the Executive Director of Vernon Hills Park District, is retiring after 15 years with our District. Matt LaPorte, a former Park District employee, will step into his shoes, and lead the District into the future.

We are continually adding new programs, especially for adults! Brew beer, make cheese, perfect your photography skills, try your hand at glass blowing, grow your writing skills, or learn healthy cooking! There are opportunities for all ages to try something new!

Did you know Lakeview Fitness offers a babysitting service for up to two hours daily while you work out? Our compassionate babysitters will engage with your children and they will have just as much fun as you are! Daily drop-in fees or discounted monthly passes are available for purchase.

If you have a little one between the ages of 2-4 years, we invite you to our Little Learners Preschool Open House on January 21. Registration for new students begins the end of January for the 2025/2026 school year.

It's almost basketball season! Our adult recreational league team registration is open until mid-December. Gather a group of friends and get out and play! Leagues for our youngest players in first and second grades begin in January, register your son or daughter today!

#### **Online Registration**

A Vernon Hills Park District online account is required for online registration. To create an account, click on the green *Register Online* button on the website home page, or complete the *Online Activation Form* available at District facilities. Online accounts allow users to re-print receipts and pay balances.

Online registration begins at 12 am on designated dates. In-person begins with regular facility hours. To receive resident rates, homeowners must live in Vernon Hills. Verified Hawthorn School District 73 participants will also qualify for resident rates.

### Proof of Residency Requirements Vernon Hills Residents

Homeowners with a valid Vernon Hills address will be assigned resident status. Vernon Hills' addresses are verified using the Lake County Geographic Information System (GIS).

#### District 73 Residents

Hawthorn School District 73 residents that live outside of Vernon Hills Park District boundaries are eligible for resident rates, except on daily admissions to Turtle Creek Waterpark.

### **Seavey Ditch Restorations**

The cleaning of the Seavey Ditch will begin. Please look for shoreline restoration, tree removal, and native planting installation. The project will begin near Hazeltime Dr. and continue through to Lake Charles itself. The goal is to provide a better, cleaner waterway for years to come.

## Lake Charles Park Plantings

The Vernon Hills Park District received a grant through the Lake County 2024 Fall Native Tree planting initiative. The grant will allow for 15 native trees to be planted at Lake Charles Park. Our staff Arborist, James Schubert, is working with the contractor to pick the ideal species and locations at Lake Charles Park to assure a long healthy life for the trees.

Jeff's Retirement follows 15 year of dedicated service to the residents of Vernon Hills

### Executive Director of the Vernon Hills Park District Jeff Fougerousse announced his retirement for October 2024

e would like to emphasize our appreciation for Jeff's past fifteen years of enthusiasm while working to progress our community's parks and leisure services.

Jeff began his career as an Executive Director at Vernon Hills Park District in 2009, and has since left a lasting impact. Jeff's personality creates an environment that breeds success. He is compassionate when listening, stead-fast in problem-solving, and follows through with great diligence. He leads with courage and a desire to make a difference. Jeff's dilligence in his work and care for his team led him to

receive the Illinois Association of Park Districts Honored Professional of the Year in 2022.

#### **Jeff Fougerousse**

There are many aspects of Jeff's personality that have allowed him to be a successful director and member of the community. His genuine and effortless ability to connect with others has allowed him to foster special relationships with constituents, peers in the Parks and Recreation field, program participants, public officials and especially his team.

Jeff's expertise and willingness to create opportunities and build partnerships have

established him as a top-tier leader in the Park District industry. He has shown his commitment to community needs through partnerships with the school district for programs like PALS Before and After school care, Turtles Swim Team, and initiating the Public Officials and Administrators Group. Furthermore, he has served on the Lions Club, Rotary, Special Recreation Association of Central Lake County board, Vernon Hills High School Career Advisory, and July 4th Village Committees, as well as Illinois Park and Recreation Association Board Chairman.

#### **Accomplishments**

Dilligently fulfilling the responsibilities of an Executive Director is a paramount priority to Jeff and has led him to significant accomplishments for the Park District. During his tenure, he obtained agency grants and alternate revenue amounting to over \$10 million.

He was instrumental in the acquisition of the Lakeview Fitness Center, and Century Park South property, as well as the many capital improvement plans including building a new Park Maintenance Facility, the Sullivan Center renovations, enhancements at Turtle Creek Waterpark, including the new Community Sprayground and many parks and playgrounds found throughout Vernon Hills.

His perseverance in making ideas come to fruition have led to enhanced patron and staff experiences. His desire to improve never slowed down over his years as Executive Director.

#### **Park District Legacy**

Jeff's kind heart and moral character have made him a mentor to countless park and recreation professionals, many of which aspire to be on his team. Under his management, the District received IPRA's Exceptional Workplace Award.

Jeff's ability to plan long term, and drive the District to constant growth and development has led the District to receiving the Government Finance Officers award of Excellence in financial reports for the past 14 years. He maintains a fiscally responsible approach

while also respecting the wants and needs of taxpayers. The District's Family Scholarship program has served over 400 families in Jeff's tenure, a testament to the impact he has left in our community.

Under Jeff's leadership, the District has also achieved significant milestones including the National Gold Medal in 2021 from the National Recreation and Park Association. The District also recieved three Distinguished Agency Accreditations from the Illinois Association of Park Districts and the Illinois Parks and Recreation Association.

## Matthew LaPorte returns to Vernon Hills as the next Executive Director

atthew LaPorte returns to Vernon Hills Park District as the agency's next Executive Director. Matt's career in parks and recreation includes over 20 years of experience, having worked in several parks and recreation agencies locally and outside of Illinois. Most recently, Matt served as Recreation Director for the Village of Libertyville and Superintendent of Recreation for the Mundelein Park and Recreation District.

His interest in parks and recreation began during his undergraduate years at the University of New Hampshire, where he studied recreation management. As a student, he began working as a recreation program aide for a local New Hampshire parks and recreation department and fulfilled various volunteering

roles working with people with disabilities at several non-profit organizations. After graduating, Matt began his recreation career at the YMCA of Greater Boston as a Sports Director. Matt furthered his experience by working in parks and recreation in Colorado for eight years where he worked in programming, facility management and special events coordination. Matt and his family moved to Illinois in 2012, where he began working for the Vernon Hills Park District. Matt was the first facility manager of Lakeview Fitness Center. He served in the position from 2012-2015, where he guided the facility through its transition from the Central Lake YMCA to the thriving Vernon Hills Park District fitness facility. His life and career experiences have cultivated



leadership skills and diversified his experience. Matt's familiarity with the Park District, the community and the surrounding villages have prepared him to successfully lead the agency.

Matt lives in Crystal Lake with his wife, their two daughters and their Australian Shepherd, Ellie. During his free time, he enjoys family movie nights, watching his daughters compete in sports, attending graduate school classes, traveling and going for long runs.

### Save a class, register early!

All classes must have a minimum number of participants registered 2-5 days before a class begins, or it will be canceled.

#### Resident/Non-Resident (NR) Fees

Vernon Hills residents significantly contribute to the operating budget of the Park District by paying property taxes. Everyone who resides within the boundaries of the Park District are eligible to receive resident discounted rates. Any resident with a valid Vernon Hills address will be assigned Resident status. All Vernon Hills addresses are verified using the Lake County Geographic Information System (GIS). Residents living within Hawthorn School District 73 are also eligible to receive resident discounted rates for programs, Lakeview Fitness memberships, and Lakeview Fitness daily passes. The only exception is daily admission to Turtle Creek Waterpark. Non-resident fees are the second fees shown in program descriptions. These rates are not discounted and are necessary in order to ensure that non-resident participants contribute to the overall financing of the park system on an equitable basis with residents.

#### Senior Citizen Discount

Senior discounts are available for individual passes and membership to Lakeview Fitness for residents aged 62 & older. For all other programs and Turtle Creek Waterpark, up to a 20% discount will be applied.

#### **Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF) Policy**

A \$25 service charge will be assessed on all checks returned due to non-sufficient funds.

#### Visual Media

- 3. Refrain from using abusive, inappropriate, or foul language.
- Refrain from threatening or causing bodily harm to self, other participants, or staff.
- 5. Show respect for equipment, supplies, and facilities.
- 6. Not possess any weapons.

### **General Information**

#### **Vernon Hills Police**

Through a cooperative agreement with the Village of Vernon Hills, all parks and park facilities are policed by the Vernon Hills Police Department. Police are radio dispatched and may be summoned by calling (847) 362-4449.

#### **Americans With Disabilities**

The Vernon Hills Park District will comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), which prohibits discrimination in the provision of programs, services, or activities to individuals with disabilities. #### **Food Allergy Policy**

The Park District will attempt to accommodate each program participant who has a food allergy in order to provide the safest learning environment possible. A Food Allergy Action Plan will be created by the District staff and parents to properly identify operational practices for parents, teachers, and children to follow. #### **No Smoking Ordinance**

In addition to the Smoke Free Illinois Act, the entire Park District which includes all facilities, buildings, parks, streets, paths, open space and all waters, is designated as tobacco free.

### **Age Qualification**

The District establishes appropriate age qualifications for each of its programs. Only the program supervisor is authorized to make exceptions to these age ranges. Consideration will only be given once all age-appropriate participants have had an opportunity to register.

### **Payment Policy**

Households with an unpaid balance will not be allowed to register for any Vernon Hills Park District programs, activities, memberships, or rentals until the balance is paid in full. For assistance with an unpaid balance contact the Customer Service Supervisor at (847) 996-6803.

#### Refunds

- A refund, minus a \$10 service charge, is granted if the request is received 10 business days before the start of the program.
- Refund requests received less than 10 days before the start of a program
  or after a program require administrative approval. The \$10 service charge
  will apply.

- No refunds are issued once 50% of the program has been completed.
- · Season passes are not refundable.
- If refunds are not applied to an account credit, they will be issued back
  to the original form of payment. If payment was cash or check, a refund
  check will be mailed in approximately 2-3 weeks, after administrative
  approval.
- The camp refund policy is unique. See Camp Guide for details.
- The Aspen Dance refund policy is unique. See Family Handbook for details.

Refund Request forms are available at the Sullivan Community Center or at Lakeview Fitness and on our website.

#### **Class Cancellations**

The Park District makes every effort to avoid canceling classes. However, in order to operate efficiently, programs must have a minimum number of registered participants 2-5 days before class start date to avoid cancellation. If a program is canceled, participants are notified prior to the start of the program and a full refund is issued.

### **Financial Aid/Scholarship Policy**

To help ensure that every resident has the opportunity to participate in recreation programs, the Vernon Hills Park District has established a financial aid program for children of the District whose parents are experiencing temporary financial difficulty. To be eligible to receive assistance, the applicant must be a resident of the Vernon Hills Park District, must apply for assistance in writing using the financial aid form provided by the District, and must provide proof of income and other documentation if requested by the District. 
