Dear Vernon Hills Residents,

Summer is our favorite time with families enjoying the parks and playgrounds, friendly competitions at our many athletic fields, outdoor special events, and relaxing by the pool.

Turtle Creek Waterpark opens for the season on May 31! There is a lot of activity at the waterpark this spring getting ready for opening day – you will notice a renovated entry, colorful murals, new signage, and the sprayground! New this year is a Splash Pass! This is a pre and post season pass to the sprayground. By adding the Splash Pass to your regular season pass, weather permitting, you can enjoy the sprayground from May 17 through September 21. Be sure to pick-up a Summer Aquatic Guide at the Sullivan Community Center to learn about the events happening at Turtle Creek Waterpark.

Camp registration has begun! With 14 unique day camps offered, kids in preschool through 10th grade can choose a camp that interests them. For kids who prefer specialty camps such as sports, robotics or art, we have those too! Most day camps are two-weeks with four sessions offered this summer allowing for variety in your child's summer fun! Our specialty camps are typically one-week.

Lakeview Fitness' outdoor patio is the first of its kind in our area. Weather permitting, classes will begin outdoors this spring. Students and staff who work at an educational institution can purchase a 3-month pass beginning May 1. I encourage you to sign-up for a free one-day visit and see all that Lakeview Fitness has to offer.

Our District continues conservation work this summer. A grant was awarded to install a Pollinator Garden at Peterson Park. This is beneficial to the environment by attracting bees and monarchs to native flowers. The Seavey Ditch Restoration Project at Hawthorn Mellody Park includes cleaning out the ditch, reforming the banks, and keeping erosion from destroying the lakes downstream.

Have fun this summer and be sure to take time to enjoy your parks.

Hawthorn School District 73 residents that live outside of Vernon Hills Park District boundaries are eligible for resident rates, except on daily admissions to Turtle Creek Waterpark.

Park News Summer 2025

Pollinator Garden

The Vernon Hills Park District Parks Department will be installing a new pollinator garden at Peterson Park this Summer. This project is being funded in part by a grant received from the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR). The garden will create a completely native habitat for local pollinators of all kinds, including bees, monarchs, native flowers and more.

Over the past few decades, a variety of factors have been responsible for a large decrease in pollinator populations. These include rising temperatures, migrations of invasive species, and increased use of pesticides. It is important to defend natural pollinators due to the essential work they do in maintaining our local ecosystems. This project intends to create a natural space to support pollinator populations and the important work they do for the environment.

Seavey Ditch Restoration

The Village of Vernon Hills is working with the Lake County Storm Water Maintenance Commission and the Vernon Hills Park District to restore the Seavey Ditch from Hazeltine Drive to Lake Charles. The restoration project will involve removing trees, cleaning out the creek, reforming the banks, and preventing erosion from filling in and damaging the lakes downstream. The banks of the creek will be planted with natives to help prevent pollution from running into the creek. The project began in March and will proceed throughout the year.



Carriage Green Playground

The Vernon Hills Park District Parks Department will be removing the old playground at Carriage Green and installing a new one this summer. The project is still in the early developmental stage but we urge everyone to keep checking our website for updates regarding the project.

5-18 Years | Skill-Based Levels | Vernon Hills High School

Bronze I

Bronze I is for beginners who are still developing legal competitive strokes. The primary focus is proper technique and building freestyle and backstroke endurance. Practices include drill progressions, lane etiquette, and learning competitive rules.

Bronze II

This team is designed for swimmers with previous lesson or beginner swim team experience. The primary focus is on refining all four competitive strokes and learning new skills such as diving and flip turns. Practices build on Bronze I by adding introductory dry-land exercises, short swim sets, and use of the pace clock.

Silver

Silver is for swimmers who are looking for consistent competition. The primary focus is on refining the four competitive strokes and building endurance. Practices include drill progressions, high intensity endurance training, and sprinting.

Gold

Gold is designed for advanced swimmers looking for near elite level of competition. The primary focus is on stroke refinement and endurance. Practices include breath control, and sprinting/distance event training.

Green

Green is designed for elite level swimmers passionate about the sport. In addition to the gold practices, team members will also learn proper nutrition, time management, and goal setting.





Save a class, register early!

All classes must have a minimum number of participants registered 2-7 days before a class begins, or it will be canceled.

Resident/Non-Resident (NR) Fees

Vernon Hills residents significantly contribute to the operating budget of the Park District by paying property taxes. Everyone who resides within the boundaries of the Park District are eligible to receive resident discounted rates. Any resident with a valid Vernon Hills address will be assigned Resident status. All Vernon Hills addresses are verified using the Lake County Geographic Information System (GIS). Residents living within Hawthorn School District 73 are also eligible to receive resident discounted rates for programs, Lakeview Fitness memberships, and Lakeview Fitness daily passes. The only exception is daily admission to Turtle Creek Waterpark. Non-resident fees are the second fees shown in program descriptions. These rates are not discounted and are necessary in order to ensure that non-resident participants contribute to the overall financing of the park system on an equitable basis with residents.

Senior Citizen Discount

Senior discounts are available for individual passes and membership to Lakeview Fitness for residents aged 62 & older. For all other programs and Turtle Creek Waterpark, up to a 20% discount will be applied.

Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF) Policy

A \$25 service charge will be assessed on all checks returned due to nonsufficient funds.

Visual Media

The District takes photographs and/or video of participants for promoting/ advertising our programs, services, events, activities, and facilities in our program guides, websites, agency social media sites, and other promotional avenues. By registering for, participating in or attending District programs, events, or other activities, the participant (or parent/ guardian of a minor participant) irrevocably agrees to the use and distribution by the Park District of his or her image (or of his minor child/ward) in photographs, video recordings, and any other electronic reproductions of such programs, events and activities for any purpose without inspection or approval and without compensation, rights to royalties or any other consideration now and in the future.

Vandalism

Discipline

A positive approach is used regarding discipline. Staff periodically reviews rules with participants during programs. If inappropriate or unacceptable behavior occurs, prompt resolution will be sought and the District Behavior Management Policy (2.39) will be used as a guideline. The Park District reserves the right to remove a participant whose actions endanger the safety of himself or others.

Food Allergy Policy

The Park District will attempt to accommodate each program participant who has a food allergy in order to provide the safest learning environment possible. A Food Allergy Action Plan will be created by the District staff and parents to properly identify operational practices for parents, teachers, and children to follow. No Smoking Ordinance

In addition to the Smoke Free Illinois Act, the entire Park District which includes all facilities, buildings, parks, streets, paths, open space and all waters, is designated as tobacco free.

Age Qualification

The District establishes appropriate age qualifications for each of its programs. Only the program supervisor is authorized to make exceptions to these age ranges. Consideration will only be given once all age-appropriate participants have had an opportunity to register.

Payment Policy

Households with an unpaid balance will not be allowed to register for any Vernon Hills Park District programs, activities, memberships, or rentals until the balance is paid in full. For assistance with an unpaid balance contact the Customer Service Supervisor at (847) 996-6803.

Refunds

- A refund, minus a \$10 service charge, is granted if the request is received 10 business days before the start of the program.
- Refund requests received less than 10 days before the start of a program or after a program require administrative approval. The \$10 service charge will apply.
- No refunds are issued once 50% of the program has been completed.
- Season passes are not refundable.
- If refunds are not applied to an account credit, they will be issued back to the original form of payment. If payment was cash or check, a refund check will be mailed in approximately 2-3 weeks, after administrative approval.
- The camp refund policy is unique. See Camp Guide for details.
- The Aspen Dance refund policy is unique. See Family Handbook for details.

Refund Request forms are available at the Sullivan Community Center or at Lakeview Fitness and on our website.

Class Cancellations

The Park District makes every effort to avoid canceling classes. However, in order to operate efficiently, programs must have a minimum number of registered participants 2-7 days before class start date to avoid cancellation. If a program is canceled, participants are notified prior to the start of the program and a full refund is issued.

Financial Aid/Scholarship Policy

To help ensure that every resident has the opportunity to participate in recreation programs, the Vernon Hills Park District has established a financial aid program for children of the District whose parents are experiencing temporary financial difficulty. To be eligible to receive assistance, the applicant must be a resident of the Vernon Hills Park District, must apply for assistance in writing using the financial aid form provided by the District, and must provide proof of income and other documentation if requested by the District. 
